Also present was Brown County Clerk Dawn Boyles. County Attorney Kevin Hill was present for a portion of the meeting. SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY

Discussed raising the county’s cost for the hot meal program due to rising costs for groceries. Currently the cost of a meal is \$4.50 with the county’s portion being \$1.80. The county’s new portion toward a hot meal would be \$2.30.
