John Merchant, Brown County Sheriff, reported there are 26 inmates, 20 males and 6 females, currently at the Brown County Jail.

**OLD JAIL**  
Commissioners discussed the options for the old jail. Valuation on the building is \$63,810. County Attorney, Kevin Hill, advised the Commissioners that the jail must be sold at a public sale after a period of publications and the Commissioners have the option to reject any or all bids. If the Commissioners decide to sell it they must follow the publication and bid process. If they would like to tear it down that would not be required. Nancy Parks Wright, Brown County resident, addressed the Commission in regards to the condition of the building. Attorney, Kevin Hill, will work on the public sale publication. Motion by Steve Roberts to put the old jail up for public auction after the three weeks of required publications. Seconded by Keith Olsen. Motion carried.
