They have been in business for 25 years. Reigle reported that the State of Kansas will soon require a 200 hour class for volunteers to be certified for EMT service. Reigle would like to stay involved another couple years, but as operator not owner. A Brown County resident is reportedly interested in purchasing the ambulance service. County Attorney Kevin Hill discussed the legal issues involved.
