MINUTES

SHERIFF

Brown County Sheriff John Merchant reported 25 inmates currently in the Brown County Jail. Merchant discussed various drug arrests and reported on the Click-it-or-Ticket campaign in Brown County.

FAIRVIEW CITY

Hillary Boye, Fairview City Attorney, presented a Petition for Annexation of the land between old Highway 75 and new Highway 75, both west of the City of Fairview.

Motion by Warren Ploeger for the Brown County Board of Commissioners to approve the annexation due to the finding and determination that the annexation of such land will not hinder or prevent the proper growth and development of the area or that of any other incorporated city located within Brown County. Seconded by Steve Roberts. Motion carried.

CD BID OPENING

Treasurer Cheryl Lippold was present for a CD bid opening on a \$200,000 CD currently held at the Union State Bank. Bids were as follows: Morrill & Janes Bank with a bid of 1.61%; Hiawatha National Bank with a bid of 1.64%; and Union State Bank with a bid of 1.725%.
