LAND PURCHASE

Ian Schuetz, Brown County resident, discussed purchasing land to access landlocked land owned by his grandmother. Commissioner Olsen suggested the Commission discuss with County Attorney, Kevin Hill, and County Clerk, Melissa Gormley, will contact Schuetz.

Hiawatha Police Chief, John Defore, joined the meeting via phone call. Defore reported procedures taken to remove barricades after the Halloween parade. Motion by Keith Olsen to suspend the lights and sirens permit for six months and requested Stover take a lights and sirens class and the Commission will review the permit in six months and determine if it should reinstated. Seconded by Dwight Kruse. Motion carried.

TOWN AND COUNTRY EMS

Duke Koerperich, Town and Country EMS Director, reported on a July incident that is being reviewed by the state. Koerperich also discussed new training he has purchased for his crew. Commissioner Olsen suggested Koerperich visit with County Clerk, Melissa Gormley, about CPR training for county employees.

SHERIFF

County Clerk, Melissa Gormley, reported the lowest condition cost value of the 2002 Durango was \$1100.00 and the 2011 Crown Vic was \$2200.00.
