The Board of Brown County Commissioners met in regular session with the following members present: Chairman Steve Roberts, Warren Ploeger and Glen Leitch. Also present were County Clerk Debbie Parker and Deputy County Clerk Marla Hathhorn. County Attorney Kevin Hill was present for a portion of the meeting.

Commissioner Steve Roberts opened the meeting at 8:00 a.m.

### **ROAD CREW JOB APPLICANT INTERVIEW**

The Commissioners interviewed an applicant for the vacant position on the road crew.

### **ROAD FOREMAN**

Road Foreman Darrin Matthias discussed projects for this week.

### **COUNTY ATTORNEY**

County Attorney Kevin Hill discussed a township road question with Commissioner Ploeger. Hill also presented a rough draft on the Horton Lake Road (Yates Avenue) contract with Horton City. The Commissioners will review the contract before a copy is sent to the Horton City Council.
