## EXTENSION DISTRICT

Nemaha County Extension Board President David Kee and Brown County Extension Board President Leroy Puvogel presented the revised 2006-projected budget for the proposed Extension districting. Kansas State University will contribute monies for six Extension agents. There are currently three agents serving the three counties.

## CENTURY HEALTH

Lisa Welch, Century Health, reported she is working on a renewal figure for the County's Employee Health insurance. Various options were discussed for reducing dental and health insurance costs. One option discussed was a $\$ 1,000.00$ deductible with $\$ 25.00$ office visit co-pay. Currently the deductible is $\$ 750.00$ with a $\$ 15.00$ office visit co-pay. Also discussed was dropping the orthodontic coverage. Welch will return on October 25 with more information.

## RDA

Nancy Gafford, RDA, presented Microloan papers for authorized signatures and reported on the Robinson Housing Project, which will renovate four homes.
