The Board of Brown County Commissioners met in regular session with the following members present: Chairman Glen Leitch and Warren Ploeger. Also present was County Clerk Debbie Parker and Deputy County Clerk Marla Hathhorn. Glen Leitch opened the meeting at 8:00 a.m.

**SHERIFF**

Lamar Shoemaker, Sheriff, reported on a fatality rollover accident occurring east of Hiawatha the past weekend. Shoemaker also discussed the \$10,000.00 radio installation block grant, which is now ready for submission.

**EXTENSION DISTRICT**

Nemaha County Extension Board President David Kee and Brown County Extension Board President Leroy Puvogel presented the revised 2006-projected budget for the proposed Extension districting. Kansas State University will contribute monies for six Extension agents. There are currently three agents serving the three counties.

**CENTURY HEALTH**

Lisa Welch, Century Health, reported she is working on a renewal figure for the County's Employee Health insurance. Various options were discussed for reducing dental and health insurance costs. One option discussed was a \$1,000.00 deductible with \$25.00 office visit co-pay. Currently the deductible is \$750.00 with a \$15.00 office visit co-pay. Also discussed was dropping the orthodontic coverage. Welch will return on October 25 with more information.

**RDA**

Nancy Gafford, RDA, presented Microloan papers for authorized signatures and reported on the Robinson Housing Project, which will renovate four homes.
