The following members were present: Warren Ploeger, Steve Roberts, and Keith Olsen. Also present were County Clerk/Election Officer Debbie Parker and Deputy County Clerk Marla Hathhorn.

Warren Ploeger opened the meeting at 8:00 a.m.

### **CANVASS OF BALLOTS**

Motion by Keith Olsen to allow Deputy County Clerk Marla Hathhorn to assist in canvassing the ballots. Seconded by Steve Roberts. Motion carried.

The April 6, 2010 Hiawatha City/Horton City General Election voting records were canvassed. There were 13 provisional ballots. Motion by Warren Ploeger to approve the counting of 11 provisional ballots, with 2 provisional ballots not counted, all according to Kansas State Statutes. Seconded by Keith Olsen. Motion carried.

Election Officer Debbie Parker reported a county-wide average 14.1 % per cent voter turnout.

Motion by Warren Ploeger to accept the April 10, 2010 Hiawatha City/Horton City General Election canvass. Seconded by Steve Roberts. Motion carried.
